### Structured learning

Learners can access 16 course modules that cover a wide variety of topics, including:

- contraception
- sexually transmitted infections
- planning pregnancy
- chlamydia and cervical screening programmes
- early pregnancy assessment, including referral for abortions
- psychosexual problems
- providing SRH for young people
- the law relating to confidentiality, sexual activity and the provision of healthcare to young people

Each module is divided into smaller e-learning sessions that users can dip into as required. *e-SRH* is available online and busy practitioners can study at home, in the workplace or even on the move.

### Interactive learning

The content includes a variety of multimedia features, such as images, video clips and animations, which help to reinforce learning. Real-life case studies also help learners to understand the views of patients and fellow professionals and apply the learning to their own area of practice.

Learners can identify individual modules that are relevant to their specialty or areas where they require further training. Self-assessment exercises also test their understanding of key concepts.

Users can track their progress online and add the details to their training or continuing professional development portfolio.

The content has been written and peer-reviewed by a multidisciplinary team of clinical experts in SRH, genito-urinary medicine and general practice. It is regularly updated to reflect the latest clinical guidance.
